Vision Month: Instead of just one “Vision Sunday” this year, pastor is taking the whole month of February to preach on and explain the vision for this new year. The first Sunday, Pastor will preach on the theme for the year. The second Sunday, he will preach on discipleship and how it might look in our church. Pastor will highlight the ministries of the church on the third Sunday as he preaches on service and how you can be involved at CBC. The last Sunday will be “looking forward” to the 2024 church calendar and “looking back” at 2023 through a video highlight presentation (shown after the service for whoever would like to stay and watch).
