Tim and Rachel Endean with CampsAbroad

Tim and Rachel joined the Camps Abroad team in 2018 as field representatives, and they are excited to be working with young people all over the world.

They both grew up in New England and benefited from attending Christian camps as teenagers. Tim counseled for parts of five summers at Christian camps, including The Wilds of New England, and Rachel served in a variety of roles at The Wilds of New England for four summers and several fall camps.

Even before they joined CampsAbroad, Tim and Rachel enjoyed ministering to teens in a variety of ways—most recently as the youth leaders at University Baptist Church in Clemson, South Carolina.

CampsAbroad is a ministry of the Wilds Christian Camp and exists to help ministries around the world establish camp programs that glorify God, build up believers, and reach people for Christ. We provide training and assistance to help national ministry leaders lay the foundations for effective camping ministries. Our involvement in each camp is temporary (we aren't involved with the long-term operation of any camp) and we don't financially support any camp, though we do provide training free of charge.



The Petersens to Poland

Tim Petersen's parents moved to Poland as missionaries when he was 4 years old. During his senior year of high school, he was called into the ministry with a burden to return to Poland as a missionary.

Claire grew up as a missionary kid in Hong Kong. She studied teaching English as a second language in college with the goal to teach overseas as a missionary.

Tim and Claire met at Bob Jones University and served together in different church ministries and outreach opportunities. They were married in 2014 and took a short term missions trip to Poland in 2018. They are currently on deputation to go Poland as full-time missionaries.
