### Not Me in March—This Month's Focus:

As Pastor introduced on Vision Sunday, we want to focus less on ourselves this year (Not Me in '23). Last month we focused on God and others. This month, we are focusing on our **neighbors**. Who are our neighbors? The parable of the Good Samaritan reminds us that when we meet the needs of someone else, we are showing love to our neighbor.
